From 1 July 2007, virtually all workplaces (including work vehicles) and substantially enclosed public areas in England will become smoke free by law.

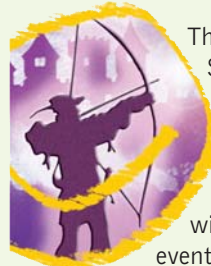
In order to comply with the legislation, businesses must ensure that they display the appropriate signage and maintain a smoke free environment.

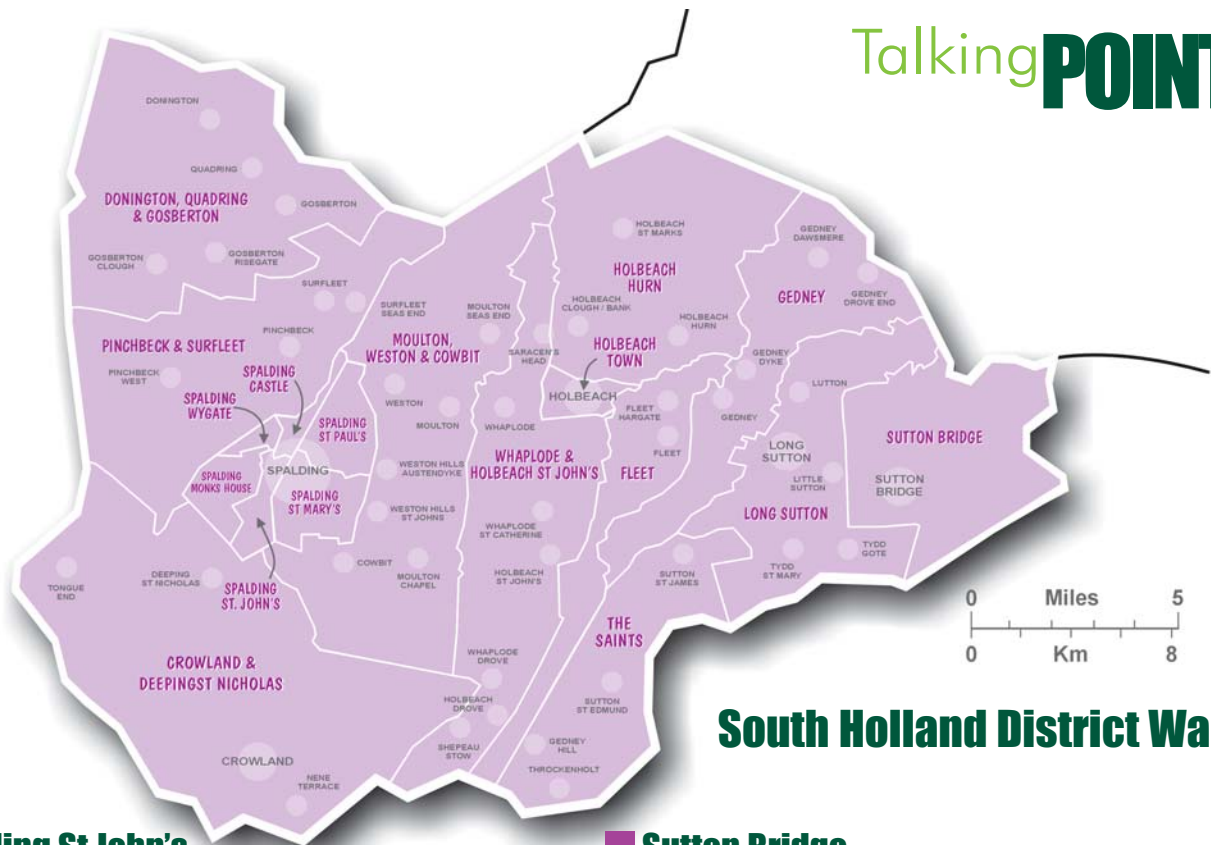
