Notice of Adoption of Proposals for the Replacement of a Local Plan

South Holland Local Plan

On 18 July 2006 South Holland District Council adopted these proposals. The adopted proposals will form part of the development plan for the area of South Holland District Council. The development plan forms the basis for decisions on land use planning affecting that area.

Copies of the adopted proposals are available for inspection at the Council Offices at Priory Road in Spalding on Mondays to Thursdays from 8:30am to 5:15pm and on Fridays from 8:30am to 4:45pm. They are also available at the Market House in Long Sutton and at the Public Libraries in Spalding, Holbeach, Long Sutton, Crowland and Donington on normal days and during normal hours of opening. Arrangements are in hand to print copies of the adopted plan which can be obtained on request and on payment of £50.00 per copy, or £55.00 per copy including postage. If you wish to request one or more copies please write to Planning Policy Team, Council Offices, Priory Road, Spalding PE11 2XE stating your requirements and we will post the plan to you and send you an invoice once copies are available, which we expect to be at the end of October 2006. Arrangements are also in hand to place an interactive version of the adopted plan on our website www.sholland.gov.uk

The proposals came into operation on their adoption. A person aggrieved by the proposals who desires to question their validity on the ground that they are not within the powers conferred by Part II of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 or that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the adoption of the proposals, may, within six weeks from 24 August 2006, make an application to the High Court under section 287 of the 1990 Act.
