

## LICENSING ACT 2003

### **NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR THE REVIEW OF A PREMISES LICENCE UNDER SECTION 51(3)**

Take Notice that the following application has been made to South Holland District Council.

Name of Applicant: The Chief Constable, Lincolnshire Police, Licensing Department, Police Station, Swingbridge Road, Grantham, NG31 7XT

The Address of the Premises to Which this Notice Relates: **SHOOTERS BAR, 19 MARKET PLACE, SPALDING, LINCS, PE11 1SU**

The Grounds of the Application for Review: A Review is sought on the grounds of the licensing objectives:

- 1) The Prevention of Crime and Disorder
- 2) Public Safety
- 3) The Prevention of Public Nuisance

The premises are licensed for: the Sale by Retail of Alcohol, Regulated Entertainment including and the Provision of Entertainment Facilities.

Since the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2009 to the current date, there have been 17 recorded incidents to Lincolnshire Police to attend this premises. Incidents include large crowds of drunken individuals resulting in crimes of assault, public order and other offences. There is also a lack of formal policies and effectiveness of door staff. This has given Lincolnshire Police serious concerns around the management of the premises in relation to these three Licensing Objectives.

Any interested party or responsible authority may make representation in writing to South Holland District Council Offices within 28 days (**before 30 November 2009**).

The Council's Register is held at South Holland District Council, Council Offices, Priory Road, Spalding, Lincs, PE11 2XE, where the record of application can be inspected.

It is an offence liable on summary conviction to a fine up to level 5 (£5,000) on the standard scale to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with the application.
