The Repossession Prevention Fund is open to any household at risk of losing their home as a direct result of the recession.

The fund is there to prevent homelessness arising from repossession and evictions for home owners and tenants.

For example:

- To support possible mortgage rescue applications
- To assist householders threatened with imminent repossession / eviction to remain in their homes
- Making a joint agreement with a lender, landlord and household to pay arrears.

You can be referred to the scheme by a Housing Advisor following an advice appointment. If you think that the Council can help you please contact us and ask for an appointment.
