ABOUT THIS DOCUMENT

As part of the Re-deposit of the Local Plan, Regulations require the Council to make available a list of changes which have been made to the Plan since the earlier First Deposit Draft in 2001. The Council is also required to indicate the changes which have been made on the Local Plan document itself.

A substantial number of changes have been made. Chapters of the Local Plan have been re-ordered and in some cases merged, whilst policy, paragraph and inset map numbering has also changed. We have sought to avoid undue repetition and in particular the 'implementation' section after each policy has been removed and the most important text retained elsewhere.

The Council has therefore produced the main Re-deposit Local Plan documentation (Written Statement and Proposals Map) as a 'clean' document without attempting to show the changes, in order that it is easy to use.

To meet the requirements of Regulations this document has been produced. It contains lists which highlight the areas of change to the First Deposit Draft. It also reproduces the main text of the First Deposit Draft written statement and provides extract maps, to show where those changes occur. (Please note that the format and page numbering in the written statement differs from that of the document printed in 2001.)

Some of the changes are described in detail in this document. However, where the changes are more fundamental or extensive then they are described in general terms. This document should therefore be read in conjunction with the Re-deposit Local Plan written statement and proposals map in order to appreciate the changes in full.

For ease of reference, each main area of change has a reference number with the prefix "RDC" (Re-Deposit Change).
