- Site Layout Plan showing your proposal and its relationship to boundaries, existing buildings, roads, footpaths, any trees and any other features that need to be taken into account.

It may also be beneficial to provide the following:

- Sketch of existing and proposed elevations (for extensions, outbuildings and porches)
- Sketch of existing and proposed floor plans (for extensions, outbuildings and porches)
- Photographs

Dimensions should be clearly indicated on any plans.
