

NOTICE OF ELECTION

UK PARLIAMENTARY ELECTION For the SOUTH HOLLAND AND THE DEEPINGS CONSTITUENCY

1. An Election is to be held for One Member of Parliament for the South Holland and the Deepings constituency.
2. Nomination Forms for the Parliamentary Election may be obtained at **Council Offices, Priory Road, Spalding, Lincolnshire, PE11 2XE** from the Acting Returning Officer.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the **Acting Returning Officer, Council Offices, Priory Road, Spalding, Lincolnshire, PE11 2XE** from Monday 11th November between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm but no later than 4 pm on Thursday 14th November 2019.
4. The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender, by means of a banker's draft or, with the Acting Returning Officer's consent, in any other manner.
5. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 12th December 2019.
6. Applications for registration must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Council Offices, Priory Road, Spalding, Lincolnshire, PE11 2XE** by no later than **midnight on Tuesday 26th November 2019**. To register to vote via the Government Website go to www.gov.uk/register-to-vote
7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Council Offices, Priory Road, Spalding, Lincolnshire, PE11 2XE** by 5 pm on Tuesday 26th November 2019.
8. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Council Offices, Priory Road, Spalding, Lincolnshire, PE11 2XE** by 5 pm on Wednesday, 4th December 2019.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at **Council Offices, Priory Road, Spalding, Lincolnshire, PE11 2XE** by 5 pm on Thursday, 12th December 2019. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 4th December 2019. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 4th December 2019.
