

Council Tax - Another bill to remember to pay!

You can now pay over 12 months

The full 12 instalments can only be given at the start of the financial year, where we have received sufficient notice for your chosen payment date. Where we cannot give 12 instalments you will be given the maximum number of instalments to the end of the financial year.

Paying by Direct Debit means you can choose when to pay your instalments each month - on the 1st, 9th, 18th or 27th. Pick the date that suits you and reminders are a thing of the past! This is why more and more people are choosing Direct Debit. You will see from the Direct Debit Guarantee that **YOU ARE STILL IN CONTROL**. Simply fill in the details below in black ink, cut along the dotted line and return the instruction to South Holland District Council.

The Direct Debit Guarantee



- This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit South Holland District Council will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request South Holland District Council to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by South Holland District Council or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society.
 - If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when South Holland District Council asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.

Your information will be processed in accordance with the law, in particular the Data Protection Act 1998.
