



When identifying a parcel it is important to specify the number of the plan on which it is full enclosed. The plan should be identified by the following details:

- 1. The National Grid Reference (NGR) of the top left corner of the plan.
- 2. The Limit of areas within which individual parcels are not shown.
- 3. To convert hectares to acres multiply by 2.47455
- 4. To convert acres to hectares multiply by 0.4047

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE

The grid lines form part of the National Grid and are at 100 metre intervals. To give a reference the position of a point to within 10 metres proceed as follows—

The grid lines form parts of the National Grid and are 100 metres intervals. To give reference defining the position of a point, you wish to within 10 metres proceed as follows:
