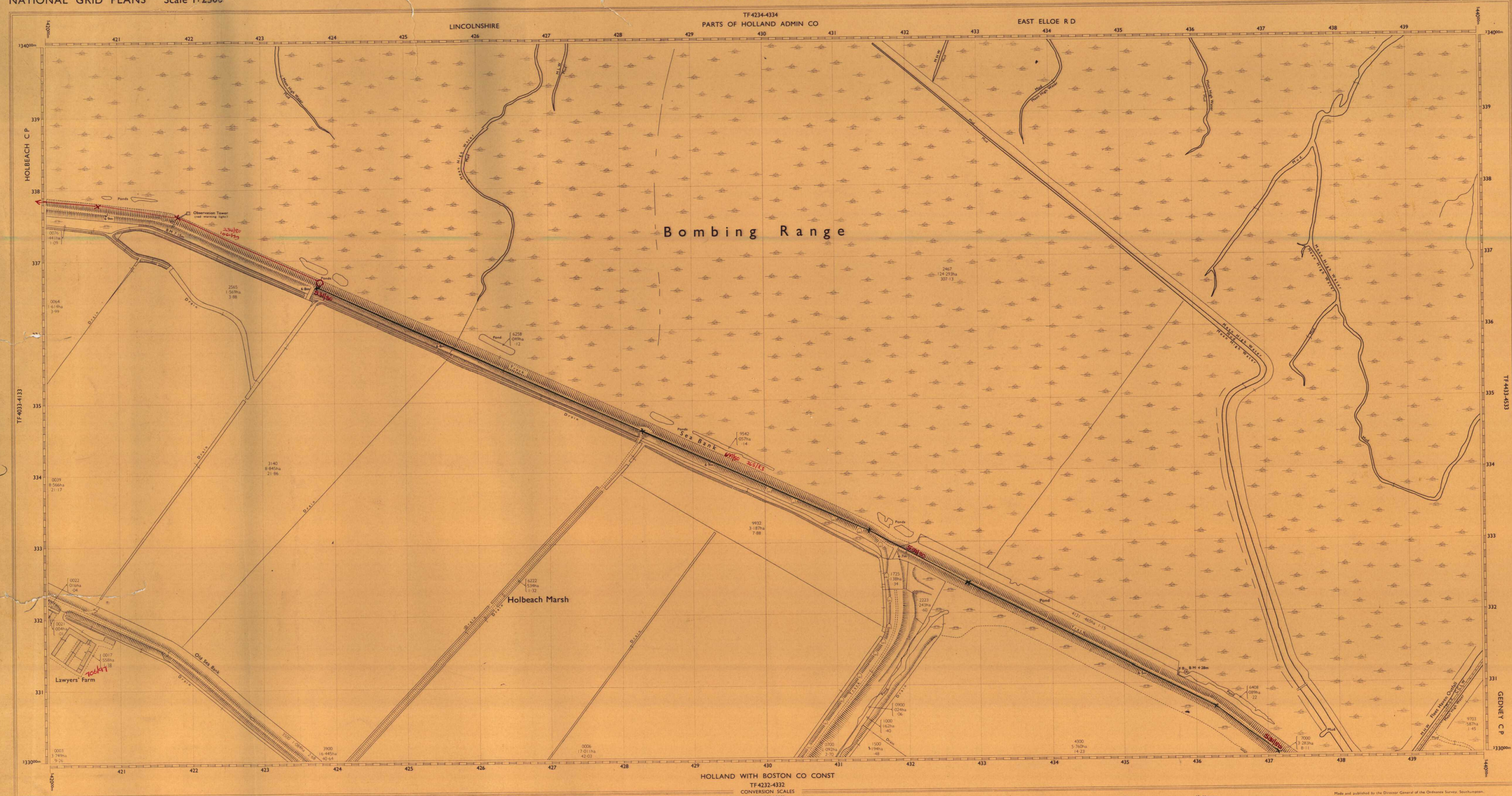

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE

The grid lines form part of the National Grid and are to 100 metres intervals. To give a reference defining the position of a point to within 10 metres proceed as follows:

EASTING
Take west edge of 100 metre square in which point lies and read the figure opposite this line on the north or south margin.
Estimate tens of metres from grid line on the point.

NORTHING
Take south edge of 100 metre square in which point lies and read the figure opposite this line on the east or west margin.
Estimate tens of metres from grid line on the point.

EXAMPLE

EASTING	426	NORTHING	332
426	332	426	332
