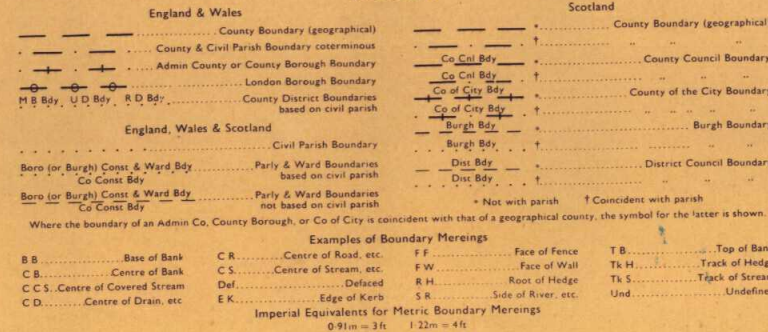




AREAS

Area measurement is to plan edge only.

The number and area, in hectares (ha) and acres, is shown within each parcel of land.

8400.....	parcel number
1 807ha.....	area in hectares
4 47.....	area in acres

When identifying a parcel it is important to specify the number of the plan on which the
Endlosures or features joined for measurement of area.

Limit of area within which individual parcels are not shown.

To convert hectares to acres multiply by 2.47105

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE

EXAMPLE: D in Dawsmere Creek	
EASTING Take west edge of 100 metre square in which point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the north or south margin Estimate tens of metres from grid line to the point	NORTHING Take south edge of 100 metre square in which point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the east or west margin Estimate tens of metres from grid line to the point
