NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE

The grid lines form part of the national grid and are at 100 metre intervals. To give a reference defining the position of a point to within 10 metres proceed as follows:

EASTING

Take west edge of 100 metres square in which point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the north or south margin. Estimate tens of metres from grid line to the point.

NORTHING

Take south edge of 100 metres square in which point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the north or south margin. Estimate tens of metres from grid line to the point.

EXAMPLE:

Point in Q 295 295
