EXAMPLE

1. The two letters preceding the sheet number are the letters of the grid square in which the point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the north or south margin.

2. The resulting four figure number is the Easting.

3. The two letters preceding the sheet number are the letters of the grid square in which the point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the east or west margin.

4. The resulting four figure number is the Northing.

5. The full six figure reference is given by writing first the letters, followed by the Easting and then by the Northing.
