

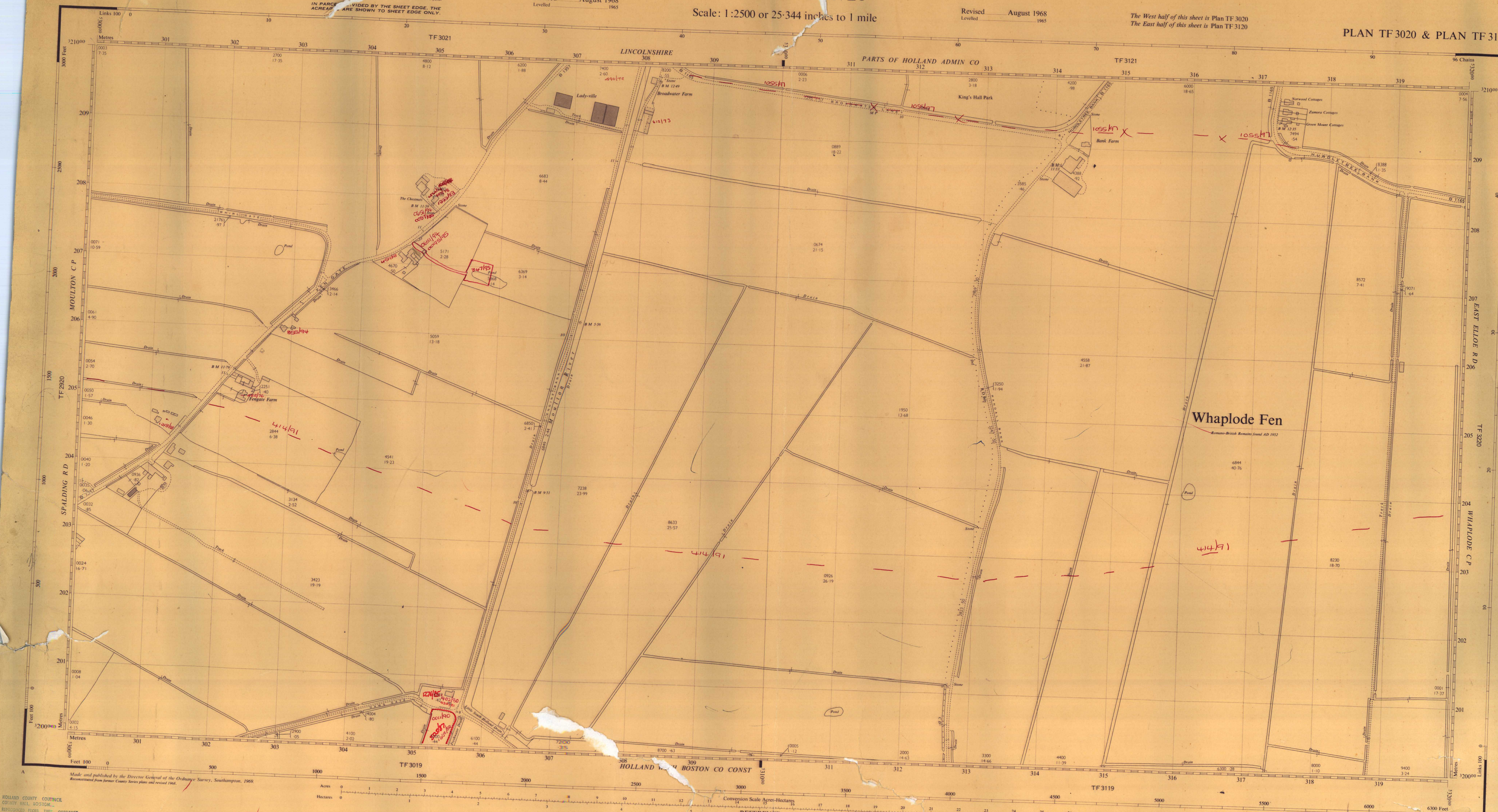
PARCEL NUMBERS AND AREAGES
