



EXAMPLE: $1\text{ acre} = 107,639\text{ sq. ft.}$ area in hectares
4.47 area in acres

When identifying a parcel it is important to specify the number of the plan on which it falls. Endlosures or features pasted on the plan should be identified by the number of the plan.

Limit of areas within which individual parcels are not shown.

To convert hectares to acres multiply by 2.474 05
To convert acres to hectares multiply by 0.404 686

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE

The grid lines form part of the National Grid and are 100 metres intervals. To give a unique reference the position of a point on a sheet is written 10 metres precise as follows:

Example from sheet TQ 058

1. Take the two letters preceding the sheet number TQ 058
2. Take the two figures following the sheet number 272
3. Read the figure opposite this line on the north or south margin 058
4. Read the figure opposite this line on the east or west margin 272
The resulting four figure number is the Easting.

5. Take the south edge of the grid square in which the point lies and read the figure opposite this line on the north or south margin 291
6. Estimate sets of metres from the grid line to the point (distance x) 291
7. Estimate sets of metres from the grid line to the point (distance y) 291
8. The full six figure reference is given by writing first the Easting and then the Northing. TQ 058291.6

2. Take the west edge of the grid square in which the point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the north or south margin.....058
Estimate tens of metres from the grid line to the point (distance e).....8
The resulting four figure number is the Easting.....0588

3. Take the south edge of the grid square in which the point lies and read the figures opposite this line on the east or west margin.....291
Estimate metres of *opposite* from the grid line to the point (distance f).....5
The resulting four figure number is the Northing.....2915

The resulting four figure number is the Northing.....2916 2916
058

4. The full ten metre reference is given by writing first the letters,
followed by the Easting and then by the Northing.....TQ 05882916.
