There are significant changes to collections for Christmas Day, Boxing Day and New Year's Day collections this year.

Otherwise Refuse & Recycling collections over the Christmas & New Year period are as normal



For Garden Waste Scheme subscribers:

There will be NO COLLECTIONS from Monday 15th December to Friday 9th January (inclusive)

Collections re-start as normal on Monday 12th January

Rubbish bags and recycling bags should be presented for collection no later than 6am on the day of collection.



You should not put out your rubbish earlier than 6pm on the day before your collection.

If household waste is put out early, it can cause problems to the area with bags being ripped open by animals and rubbish scattered across the footpath and road, this may be considered fly-tipping.



If you see a litter bin full please report it and don't leave litter on the ground, this is considered fly-tipping. You can report an overflowing bin via the link below.
