

Instructions on how to use the Public register

You will need to access the licensing page via the South Holland website.

You should then see the image below

Click on Register of South Holland Licences (see red arrow)



You will notice that it gives you a licence number, licence type, application type, application number, and a from and to date.

The from date is the commences date of the licence and the to date is the expiry date of the licence.

If you click on the blue licence number it will then open up another screen which will give you the licence details (see red arrow) You are also able to view where the premises is located on a map by clicking on View on Map (see yellow arrow)

The applications are shown with the oldest application at the top and the most recent at the bottom.

You are able to see who the applicant is and what the permitted activities are and the premises granted hours.

For this example the applicant was STP properties Ltd, the premises has been granted the supply of alcohol on and off the premises and the permitted times are from 11am until midnight Monday to Sunday

The Designated Premises Supervisor is Mr Kevin McCabe. You are also able to view and conditions attached to the licence and a plan of the premises.
